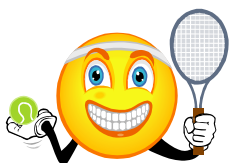

The Rules:

- A match consists of:
 - 1 Men's singles match 1 Women's singles match
 - 1 Men's doubles match 1 Women's doubles match
 - 2 Mixed doubles matches
- A team must have a minimum of 3 men and 3 ladies
- Game scoring: the scoring is no-ad. This means a game is won by the first team to win four points (1,2,3,game). When the game score is deuce (3, 3) (game point), the receiving team chooses which side is to receive the serve. In the mixed doubles set, the serve must be gender to gender on game point.
- Set scoring: a match consists of six no-ad sets and includes one set men's and women's singles and doubles, and two sets of mixed doubles. Each no-ad set is won by the first team to reach six games. A nine-point tie-breaker will be played at five games all in any set.
- Match scoring: all matches will be determined by total games won. If there is a tie at the end of all the games, there will be an overtime session. The overtime session is a mixed doubles Super Tie-Breaker.
- Substitutions: a player can substitute in any time. The player that substituted in can only stay in for a maximum of 3 games. This applies to doubles and mixed doubles. The team must be substituted. One player can remain from the original pairing. Maximum play for one player is 6 games.
- Service lets: lets will be played. When a serve hits the net and bounces within the service court, the ball is playable. In doubles, either player on the receiving side may return the ball after it bounces. If a player on the court calls "let", the team loses the point. If players on both teams call "let" then the point will be replayed.
- Coaching and positive reinforcement is encouraged for both teams. However, there is no coaching allowed during the play of the point. Don't be afraid to cheer your team on!
